Histology credit exam rules for General Medicine students in the summer semester of the academic year 2024/25

Credit exam

The following conditions have to be met in order to pass the credit exam:

- 1. Attend the practical courses **no more than two classes missed are allowed** per semester.
- 2. Pass 3 general histology written tests in MOODLE
 - The tests will be accessible in the following MOODLE course https://moodle.lfp.cuni.cz/course/view.php?id=612. Students are obligated to enroll themselves to the course based on their study programme and study group.
 - The topics of each test will include the general histology chapters, that will be taught during the practical classes.
 - Each test will be composed of a combination of "multiple-choice questions",
 "single best answer" type questions and of virtual description of the histology
 slides. The time limit will be adjusted according to the number of the questions.
 - The minimal score to pass the test is **80 % of correct answers** in each test.
 - Students have only **3 attempts** to pass each test.
 - The tests have to be fulfilled during an exact period, which will be set in advance. The period is usually 2–3 weeks long.
 - The test will be considered failed:
 - if students don't reach the limit of 80 % of correct answers in any of the 3 attempts
 - or if students don't pass the test during the set period.
 - In case students fail any of the tests, THEY WILL HAVE TO TAKE A FINAL TEST. The topics of the final test will include all the general histology chapters. The number of questions will be higher than the total number of all questions from the 3 regular tests. The minimal score to pass the test will be 90 % of correct answers. Students will have multiple attempts to pass the final test. Students, that passed all 3 regular tests during the semester, are not required to take the final test.
 - If students do not pass the written tests, any of the 3 regular tests or the final test, they will not be able to proceed to the next part of the credit exam.
- 3. Pass the **practical examination** at the end of the semester (identification and description of histological slides).
 - The final credit exam consists of:
 - Drawing of 2 general histology schemes as required for the final exam.
 - Practical oral examination (identification and description of histological slides – student receives 2 slides. Students then identify, draw and describe tissues in the slides in front of an assistant from our department.
 - Students have only 3 attempts to fulfill this requirement.

If students do not pass the practical examination during the teaching period of
the semester, but still have some attempts remaining, they can pass the credit
exam during the examination period. The teacher may offer up to two special
terms for that purpose. No other terms will be provided, especially not beyond
the examination period.
